Each seat dangles from a sturdy wire system, attached to one of 12 spires on a sphere. After every seat is filled, the sphere orbits 100 feet in the air, twirling riders at a near heart-stopping 30 miles per hour. As riders swing around the tower, they can reach heights of 100 feet – or 10 stories – off the ground!
