

Spring Fair Trivia



- 338,400 Feet of toilet paper, enough to reach from the ground to the tip of the Space Needle (605') over 559 times, was flushed away during the 4-day Spring Fair.
- 264,600 Feet, or 182 Empire State Buildings (over 1,453' in height), placed one on top of the other would equal the length of paper towels used to dry freshly washed hands in restrooms.
- 212,694 Visits on the Spring Fair website were made in March and April 2007.
- 203,000 Coupons were sent to local schools for student use.
- 170,000 Rides on carnival rides.
- 99,423 **Guests attended the 2007 Spring Fair in Puyallup.**
- 76,000 Warm scones, dripping with butter and raspberry jam were welcome treats to Spring Fair guests.
- 17,467 Advance gate admission tickets were sold.
- 7,104 Ears of corn were roasted to perfection and served.
- 5,000 Carmel apples tempted tummies and delighted local dentists.
- 3,758 Members of the military (active, retired, reserve) and their dependents enjoyed free gate admission on KVI 570 AM-partnered Military Appreciation Day.
- 3,710 Kids had their faces painted, free of charge.
- 3,421 Guests enjoyed playing State Roofing's Plinko Game.
- 3,312 Extreme riders enjoyed the thrills of the Extreme Scream.
- 2,000 Telephone calls were received a month in March and April concerning the Spring Fair.
- 1,995 Children planted a seed, thanks to the help of Master Gardeners.
- 1,124 Entries were submitted in the Creative Kids Exhibit.
- 731 Garbage bags will filled in the restrooms alone.
- 675 Rhododendron trusses and plants were entered in the annual Garden Show's Rhododendron Show.
- 290 Students participated in Puyallup School District's "Exploration 2007" Science Fair.
- 212 Children were bit players in the Let's Pretend Wild West Show.
- 157 Pygmy goats scampered into the sight of Spring Fair guests at the annual show.
- 120 Contestants in the *Txt 2 win!* text messaging contest.
- 73 Boer goats were shown at their show at the Spring Fair.
- 36 Sheep were included in the annual Shepherds' Extravaganza.
