








SPRING FAIR TRIVIA

Fascinating, foolish and fun facts from the 2010 Spring Fair in Puyallup

- 438,562 Feet of toilet paper was used. That equals over 2,370 Extreme Scream rides standing one on top of the other (185').
- 287,698 Feet of paper towels were used to dry wet hands during the Spring Fair. That equals over 108 times on the Spring Fair in Puyallup's Roller Coaster track (2,650' in length) lined up end to end. 
- 203,130 Coupons were sent to local schools for student use.
- 158,495 Visits on the Spring Fair website were made in March and April.
- 142,749 Rides taken on carnival rides. 
- 126,993 Fun-loving, happy guests attended the four-day 2010 Spring Fair in Puyallup. 
- 76,500 Warm scones, dripping with butter and raspberry jam were welcome treats.
- 17,694 Advance gate admission tickets were sold.
- 6,982 Garbage bags were filled with non-recycled waste. 
- 5,250 Kids had their faces painted, free of charge.
- 5,077 Members of the military (active, retired, reserve) and dependents enjoyed free gate admission on Military Appreciation Day.
- 4,800 Carmel apples put a smile on the face of young and old alike.
- 2,800 Phone calls regarding Spring Fair were received in March and April. 
- 2,729 Extreme riders enjoyed the thrills of the Extreme Scream.
- 2,600 Children planted a seed in KidZone, thanks to the help of Master Gardeners. That's one seed for every athlete in the 2010 Olympics.
- 1,268 Entries were submitted in the Creative Kids Exhibit.
- 900 Pounds of plastic bottles were sent to be recycled. 
- 215 Children were bit players in the Let's Pretend Pirate Adventure.
- 200 Pounds of aluminum cans were sent to be recycled. That's almost one pound for every country in the world.
- 150 Pygmy goats were shown in the annual Pygmy Goat show in 2010.
- 21 Days of people being fed at Puyallup Food Bank, thanks to the opening day food drive.
- 7 Floral design entries received from florists at the Garden Show.
- 3 Attendance records were beaten at the 2010 Spring Fair – on Friday, Sunday, and the total attendance.
