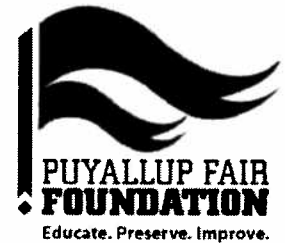


**To:** Anderson Criminal Justice Scholarship Applicants

**Regarding:** Application process for the 2012/2013 Anderson Criminal Justice Scholarship



One scholarship will be awarded for \$1,250 per year, up to four years, as long as the student is still in a Criminal Justice Program when their major is declared:

1. Scholarship must be used in contiguous years.
2. The scholarship was designed to be flexible with regard to the recipient's choice of either a two or a four-year institution.
3. This scholarship is limited to Washington State residents only and who are starting their post secondary education in the Fall/Autumn quarter of 2012.
4. Must attend a college in the state of Washington.
5. An annual review by the Puyallup Fair Foundation Scholarship Committee will be made before renewal of the scholarship. Recipient must submit a transcript of prior year's grades by July 15<sup>th</sup> each year.

This scholarship is intended to assist recipients in reaching their career goals. Applicants must use the scholarship monies to obtain training from a college, university or accredited trade or vocational school in Washington State. The monies may be used for books and tuition only and will be paid directly to the institution or school.

1. Application must be accompanied by a one-page cover letter addressing applicant's:
  - Career goals – why are you pursuing Criminal Justice?
  - Academic and/or community awards
  - Financial need including information regarding the receipt of other scholarships
2. Application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation:
  - One from a scholastic contact and the other from a community contact
  - Letters must have been written within 12 months of application submission date and include current phone numbers and addresses for both writers
  - Letters of recommendations written by relatives of the applicant are not allowed
3. Application must be accompanied by unofficial copies of the applicant's academic transcripts from high school or current transcript from secondary educational institution.
4. Application must be signed by the applicant.
5. Completed application must be postmarked or delivered to the address below on or before March 23, 2012. Applications received after the date specified above will not be considered.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Incomplete or incorrectly completed applications will not be considered.
