## OPEN RABBIT SHOW RULES

All exhibitors in this show agree to abide by the following rules:

1. The Rabbit, Poultry and Cavy Barn will be open to receive exhibits on Monday, Sept. 20, 2010 between 6 am and 8 am. No rabbits or cavies are allowed in the barn prior to 6 am. Entrance to the grounds is at the Service Gate on 5th Street SW (off of 15th Avenue SW). Late entries will not be accepted.
2. Complete entry carefully. Be sure to include the name of breed, the color variety, the class in which it is to be judged, its ear number, and whether it is to be entered in fur class. See entry example on next page.
3. All entries in fur and wool classes must be entered in open class.
4. Fur classes will be listed under each breed, plus normal white fur and normal color fur. ARBA Standard of Perfection rules apply.
5. A fryer pen will consist of three (3) rabbits, all the same breed and variety. Age limit is not over 10 weeks old, weight limit is between three (3) and five (5) pounds for each rabbit. Entries will not be dressed out.
6. Single fryers may not be over 10 weeks old, weight must be between three (3) and five (5) pounds. Entries will not be dressed out.
7. Roasters and Stewers - Entries must be entered in breed class.
8. Roasters - All rabbits in this class must be less than six (6) months of age, and must weigh between five (5) and eight (8) pounds.
9. Stewers - All rabbits in this class must be six (6) months of age or older, and weigh a minimum of eight (8) pounds.
10. All rabbits must be entered in owner's name.
11. **Ear changes** will be allowed before 8 am on check-in day and will cost \$2.00 each. **No other changes will be allowed.**
12. Any rabbit showing symptoms of any disease as determined by the veterinarian, WILL NOT be allowed in the barn.
13. Animals showing symptoms of illness during the show will be removed to a special holding area and the owner will be notified by show officials to pick up their animal.
14. All rabbits must have a permanent, legible ear tattoo or tag to correspond with the entry form. Tattoos for rabbits will be available in the barn upon arrival for \$2.00 per animal.
15. We reserve the right to substitute judges if necessary.
16. When there is no competition, the judge will place the rabbit first, or not worthy of award.

17. The greatest possible care will be given all exhibits, but the management will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage that occurs. THE SPECIMEN IS BEING ENTERED AT THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER. The Puyallup Fair will furnish feed and water for the animals.
18. No selling of rabbits or cavy's will be allowed in the barn, nor will "For Sale" signs be permitted in the barn or Fair property.
19. ABSOLUTELY NO BREEDING ALLOWED ON GROUNDS. NO EXPECTANT DOES MAY BE ENTERED.
20. All exhibits must be removed Wednesday evening, September 22 between 6 pm and 7 pm. **Solid bottom** push carts, wagons, etc., will make rabbit removal easier. Rabbits not removed by 7 pm Wednesday night will be disposed of at the discretion of the show superintendent.

ANIMALS RELEASED TO A PERSON OTHER THAN THE OWNER MUST SHOW WRITTEN PERMISSION TO SHOW OFFICIALS. Such a document must bear date and the signature of the owner.

21. If there are more entries than space will allow, those entries registering first will be accepted. Entries will be limited to 45 rabbits per person, and a total of 700 rabbits in the Youth/Open show.
22. DURING THE FAIR, ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OFF THE GROUNDS BY 9 AM, OR THEY WILL BE TOWED AWAY.
23. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own screw-on or clip-on feed dishes (see illustration on entry sheet). You may bring and install your own water bottles. Fair staff will ONLY maintain screw-on, clip on, and fair supplied containers, but not water bottles.
24. NO animal may be removed from the showroom prior to 6 pm on September 22 without permission of the show committee. NO EXCEPTIONS.
25. Any animals removed before 6 pm on Wednesday for any reason will automatically forfeit premiums and awards. NO EXCEPTIONS.
26. **Eating in the barns vs. E. coli O157:H7 – Exhibitor Cooperation Needed.**


This year our barns will not only have signage reminding Fair guests to "Wash your hands upon leaving any livestock area", but also "Please refrain from eating in livestock areas".

The State Health Department has asked the Fair to request of our livestock exhibitors to set an example for Fair guests and refrain from eating in most areas of the barns. In order to accommodate the Health Department's request, as well as address our exhibitors' needs, we have set aside an area, screened from public view, in the south end of the dairy barn for exhibitors to eat.

**EXPLANATION OF SAMPLE ENTRY FORM**

BE SURE TO INCLUDE EAR NUMBER. A TATTOO CAN BE PUT IN EAR WHEN ANIMAL ARRIVES FOR A COST OF \$2.00. YOU CAN USE LETTERS, NUMBERS OR COMBINATION OF BOTH, UP TO FIVE DIGITS.

Name and address, of course, are very important. Please include your PHONE NUMBER as clarification of entry may be necessary. Please write clearly so that your information can be properly captured.

Class numbers follow this explanation. (Bucks are male rabbits - Does are female rabbits.)

Sections marked Senior, Intermediate, Junior and Pre-Junior are determined by the age of the rabbit.

6 Section Heavyweight Classes include:  
 Seniors ..... eight months and older  
 Intermediates ..... six and seven months old  
 Juniors ..... three months through five months old  
 Pre-Juniors ..... less than three months  
 (Pre-Juniors do not compete with above classes for Best of Breed)

4 Section Middleweight and Lightweight Classes are:  
 Seniors ..... over 6 months  
 Juniors ..... 6 months and younger

\*NOTE: In some of the above classes, a rabbit's weight may determine that the animal should be shown in the class above the age limit listed, so check individual breed standard.

Be sure to include EAR NUMBER. Tattoo can be put in ear when animal arrives at a cost of \$2.00. Before an animal can be entered in any fur class, it must first be entered in type competition. Fur classes have their own class numbers.

In the example, the Dutch Junior Doe was first entered in type competition (Class 4210), then the same animal was entered in Breed Fur (Class 4211) and will be judged against other Dutch entries in Breed Fur. The second fur entry for the Dutch Doe is in Open Fur (Class 4360) and it will then be judged against all breeds entered in Fur competition. An entry fee is charged for each class entered.

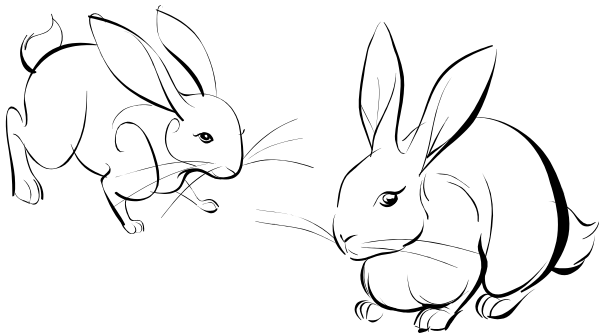
The White Rex Senior Doe is entered in type competition (Class 4150), and then in Rex Fur competition (Class 4151).

## OPEN CAVY SHOW RULES

ALL EXHIBITORS IN THIS SHOW AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES:

1. The Rabbit, Poultry and Cavy Barn will open to receive exhibits on MONDAY, SEPT. 20, 2010 between 6 am and 8 am. No rabbits or cavies allowed in the barn prior to 6 am. Entrance to the grounds is at the Service Gate on 5th Street SW (off of 15th Avenue SW).
2. Complete entry carefully. Include the name of breed, color variety, class in which it is to be judged, and ear tag number. See entry example on page 12.
3. All cavies must be entered in owner's name.
4. **Ear changes** will be allowed before 8 am on the day of the show, and ear changes are \$2.00 each. **No other changes will be allowed.**
5. Any cavy showing symptoms of any disease as determined by the veterinarian WILL NOT be allowed in the barn.
6. Animals showing symptoms of illness during the show will be removed to a special holding area, and the owner will be notified by show officials to pick up their animal.
7. All cavies must have a permanent, legible ear tag to correspond with entry.
8. We reserve the right to substitute judges, if necessary.
9. When there is no competition, the judge will place the cavy first, or not worthy of award.

10. The greatest possible care will be given all exhibits, but the management will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage that occurs. THE SPECIMEN IS BEING ENTERED AT THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER. The Puyallup Fair will furnish feed and water for the animals.

11. No selling of rabbits or cavies will be allowed in the barn, nor will "For Sale" signs be permitted in the barn or on Fair property.

12. ABSOLUTELY NO BREEDING ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.

13. All exhibits must be removed WEDNESDAY evening September 22, between 6 pm and 7 pm. **Solid bottom** push carts, wagons, etc. will make animal removal easier. Animals not removed by 7 pm Wednesday night will be disposed of at the discretion of the show superintendent.

ANIMALS RELEASED TO A PERSON OTHER THAN THE OWNER MUST SHOW WRITTEN PERMISSION TO SHOW OFFICIALS. Such a document must bear date and the signature of the owner.

14. If there are more entries than space will allow, those entries registering first will be accepted. Entries will be limited to 30 cavies per person, and a total of 200 cavies in the show.

15. DURING THE FAIR ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OFF GROUNDS BY 9 AM, OR THEY WILL BE TOWED AWAY.

16. Please bring and install your own water bottle. Fair staff will maintain cavy water bottles.

17. NO animal may be removed from the barn prior to 6 pm. Wednesday, September 22 without permission of the show committee. NO EXCEPTIONS.

18. Any animals removed before 6 pm Wednesday for any reason will automatically forfeit premiums and awards. NO EXCEPTIONS.

19. **Eating in the Barns vs. E. coli O157:H7 – Exhibitor Cooperation Needed.**

This year our barns will not only have signage reminding Fair guests "to wash your hands upon leaving any livestock area" but also "please refrain from eating in livestock areas".

The State Health Department has asked the Fair to request of our livestock exhibitors to set an example for Fair guests and refrain from eating in most areas of the barns. In order to accommodate the Health Department's request, as well as address our exhibitors' needs, we have set aside an area, screened from public view, in the south end of the dairy barn for exhibitors to eat.
