- Although every precaution will be made to protect the art pieces, the Western Washington Fair will not be responsible for theft, loss or damage to entries.
- All work must be titled! Untitled work will be rejected!
- Exhibitor must fill out an official **Electronic entry form** for each piece of work entered. Each entry form has TWO parts to fill out and when it is filled out it must be attached to the **back** of the entry. All works must stay in the show the full run of the Fair. Fair dates for 2009 are September 11 - 27.
- The Fair reserves the right to reject any work it finds objectionable.
- Please limit work to 2 (two) pieces per student. Any work deemed to heavy for safe display will not be accepted at the discretion of show management.
- Limit size of work to 18"x 24" including frame or equivalent square inches, Frames with glass should be no larger than 9"x 12" any thing larger will not be accepted at the discretion of show management.
- Any work not properly assembled or that becomes unassembled during hanging will not be displayed.
- All pencil, charcoal, chalk and pastels must be fixed.
- All work such as Masks, Ceramics or 3D work must have hangers attached.
- We would greatly appreciate School labeled Portfolios/folders for teacher drop off.
